# What should I be working on now?

Kindergarten: Module 6- Analyze, compare, create, and compose shapes

Grade 1: All modules should be completed. Please revisit the following: make ten to add/subtract, number bonds, addition/subtraction and real world problem solving using bar modeling.

Grade 2: Module 7- recognizing angles, faces, and vertices of shapes

Grade 3: Module 7- Quadrilaterals and more challenging word problems

Grade 4: Module 6- Exploring multiplication

Grade 5: Module 6- Graphing/problem solving

## How can I begin to prepare my students for the next grade?

Focus on the foundational standards outlined in Module 1. Foundational standards are the prerequisite skills needed to master the content taught in the module.
