WHEREAS, during the course of the legal action the District entered into negotiations with Pav-Lak, as part of a Court sponsored non binding Mediation, pursuant to the Court's Commercial Division Rules, which resulted in the District and Pav-Lak entering into a Stipulation, dated September 15, 2010, designed to resolve all claims and open balances on the Project, subject to the approval of the Board of Education (the "Board") of the District.

BE IT FURHTER RESOLVED, that the Roosevelt Board of Education hereby will retroactively increase the salary of the Superintendent of Schools, Robert-Wayne Harris, in accordance with the compensation established by the Commissioner of Education in the Modification and Extension of Employment Agreement by and between Roosevelt Union Free School District and Robert-Wayne Harris. The Superintendent of Schools, Robert-Wayne Harris shall be paid, as a base annual salary, for the period of July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2011, the sum of Two Hundred Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$215,000.00) retroactive to July 1, 2010. All other provisions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect."
