**WHEREAS**, in recognition of this service and the sacrifices that it entailed, on December 8, 2013 Governor Cuomo signed a bill to allow school districts to partially exempt property owned by certain qualified veterans; and

**WHEREAS**, such bill requires the governing body of a school district to pass a resolution to adopt such bill, now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED**, that the Roosevelt Union Free School District does hereby adopt the exemption provided for in Real Property Tax Law ("RPTL) Section 458-a; and be it further

**RESOLVED**, that the maximum exempt amount shall be as follows: \$\frac{\$12,000}{}\$ for all eligible recipients of the exemption provided for under RPTL Section 458-a, \$\frac{\$8,000}{}\$ for all veterans who served in a "combat zone" as that term is defined under RPTL Section 458-a \$\frac{\$40,000}{}\$ for all veterans who suffered a "service connected" disability as that term is defined under RPTL Section 458-a; and be it further

**RESOLVED**, that the Roosevelt Union Free School District does hereby adopt the expanded definition of the term "qualified owner" as that term is defined under RPTL Section 458-a, to include a "Gold Star Parent" as that term is defined under RPTL Section 458-a; and be it further

**RESOLVED**, that the Roosevelt Union Free School District does hereby allow a cooperative corporation to be eligible to receive such exemption pursuant to RPTL Section 458-a (6)(d); and be it further

**RESOLVED**, that the Roosevelt Union Free School District does hereby allow a qualified veteran under RPTL Section 458-a to transfer, on a pro-rated basis, his exemption to another home purchased within the Roosevelt Union Free School District.
