The scholarship recognizes leadership and academic distinction, as well as character and personal qualities. The Nassau County Chapter of Jack and Jill of America will be awarding several one-time scholarships.

DEADLINE: Applications are due to the Counseling Center by March 25, 2022

LOOK BACK GIVE BACK FOUNDATION, INC. SCHOLARSHIPS: Online application required. Founded in 2020, the Look Back Give Back Foundation, Inc. is a 501(c)(3) non-profit charitable organization that supports education endeavors. Their mission is to provide financial support to Black or African American high school students who seek to further their education in college, but face socio-economic hardships. Under the 2022 Scholarship Program, one scholarship in each scholarship category will be awarded to seniors of Black or African American descent currently residing and attending high school in a city or town in the states of Alabama, Arkansas, District of Columbia, Florida, Georgia, Maryland, New York, Pennsylvania, Texas, Virginia or West Virginia.

The Catharyn DeKine Scholarship

Applicants for this scholarship must have a minimum weighted average of 80% or a 3.0 on a 4.0 scale in all science subjects and an overall weighted average must be at least 80% or a 3.0 on a 4.0 scale. Applicants must plan to major in an aspect of science (Chemistry, Biology, Biotechnology, Astronomy, Astrophysics, ect.) in college. The applicant must submit an essay of no less than 600-words which display leadership and a passion for the career in the sciences. The successful applicant will also have at least 20 hours of community service, and attend high school in Nassau County or Queens.

The Andrea Hill Scholarship

This scholarship is open to Special Education students who have been accepted into a four-year institute of higher learning. Applicants must provide recommendations from at least two teachers and have an overall average of at least 75% or a 2.0 on a 4.0 scale. Applicants must attend high school in Nassau County, Queens, or Brooklyn.
